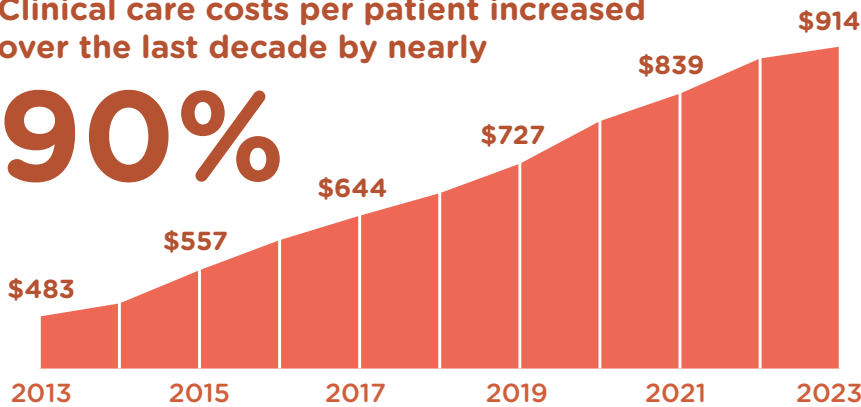





Most CHC patients rely on Medicaid

CHCs serve 1 in every 5 Medicaid beneficiaries statewide, and our rate of patients with no insurance is nearly 3x the NYS average

*Other includes Medicare and Non-CHP public programs

New York's Community Health Centers serve everyone, regardless of their immigration status, insurance coverage, or ability to pay. Our patients are racially and ethnically diverse, live in rural and urban areas, and speak many different languages. The vast majority of them are on public insurance programs, are uninsured, or qualify for discounts due to high costs of their insurance plan. **Learn more at chcanys.org.**
